

September Return to School

What I need to know

- **Do not send children to school who are showing Covid 19 symptoms.**
- **Children who have had sickness or diarrhoea must not return to school until 48 hours have past since the last incidence of sickness.**
- One-way system- Entry by front gate drop off / pick up from classroom door. Leave site by gate onto Smoot or large field gate (Weather dependent) This system prevents two-way traffic in narrow entrance.
- **Do not go through the car park.**
- Families with children in more than one class 8.40am-8.45am drop off and 2.55pm -3.05pm pick up
- Families with one child 08.45am- 8.50am drop off and 3.05 -3.15pm pick up.
- Class One Reception 9.00am drop off, pick up from 3.00pm (parents may go to the canopy area to drop off)
- One adult per family in the school grounds.

- Children in Class One and Two will be in one 'bubble', Class Three and Four will be separate 'bubbles'. The 'bubbles' will not mix at playtimes or lunch time.
- Children may only bring coats, PE kit and bag, plastic lunch box, book bag into school. No other items please.
- Reading books will be sent home.
- No water bottles
- Staff will move between 'bubbles' but this will be minimised.
- Staff will aim to maintain a 2m distance from children
- Children will not be expected to social distance, rooms will be arranged with forward facing desks where possible*
- We will notify you if a child or staff member tests positive but will not name individuals.
- If an individual tests positive, then the 'bubble' they are in will close for fourteen days. The school will notify the authorities and follow any further advice given.
- Parents may only enter the building by prior arrangement.
